# 2006 GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS READ CAREFULLY BEFORE MAKING ENTRIES

Entries Close October 23, 2006

1. Condition of Competition: Every Class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20.00 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempt from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program) 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deus and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. Also exempt from this requirement are citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 8) USEF beginner novice division; 9) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

## U.S. EQUESTRIAN ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a U.S. Equestrian-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, or Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of U.S. EQUESTRIAN (the Federation) and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR1502.5.

The competition and its management agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the CHJA, its directors, officer, committee members, agents and employees from and against all loss or damage including any and all claims arising out of the competition, including claims as to personal injury or property loss or damage suffered during or in conjunction with the competition, whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from negligent acts or omissions of said directors, officers, committee members, agents or employees. Reference to the "competition" in the foregoing statement shall pertain to the Show For Champions.

Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the horse show management, but the show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the individual horse show and the officials employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of each horse show and the facilities at which each horse show is held as well as CHJA and its Board of directors blameless for any loss or accident of his/hers horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other causes.

All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, building and other properties on the show grounds and shall be billed accordingly.

Any exhibitor lodging a protest must first deposit \$100 with the secretary of the show, which sum shall be forfeited to the Horse Show, if same is not sustained. All protests must be in writing, signed by the protester and filed with the Show Secretary within 48 hours of the occurrence of the alleged violation. If the protest is sustained, the entities standing next in award shall be moved up accordingly. A protest may be filed with the Show Manager, Show Secretary, or member of the Show Committee.

2. **Stalls and Arrival and Departure Dates:** Stalls will be available from 8:00 a.m. Monday, November 6, 2006 through Sunday, November 12, 2006. All stalls are permanent and approximately 10' x 10' or 8' x 10' with doors. No refunds after closing of entries. All exhibitors will be charged a fee for nails put into any stall.

3. **Grounds Fee:** Grounds fee of \$25 will be charged each day a horse is on grounds but does not purchase a stall.
4. **Entry Procedure:**
- A) For each horse entered send \$35 Entry Deposit or Jumper Nomination Fee (see division) along with \$150 Stall Fee postmarked by October 23, 2006. Stalls will be \$160 after October 23, 2006.
  - B) **Bedding may be ordered in advance - see entry form. Shaving are \$7 per bag.**
  - C) Bring a check for the remainder of fees to the show. No numbers will be issued without full payment. A signed open check may be left for classes that are added during the show.
  - D) **Do not** make entries from the time schedule. Consult the index to classes. Time schedules are subject to change after the close of entries. Upon arrival at the show check the time schedule in the Horse Show Office.
  - E) In all cases the description on the entry blank must fully identify the horse. The word "entry" will not be accepted. Misrepresentation of a horse's name, eligibility for a class or on the entry blank for any horse shall result in the forfeiture of any trophy, ribbon and/or cash prize won by such misrepresentation, and subject the exhibitor to further penalty.
5. **Post Entries:** A \$35 late fee will be charged to entries received after the closing date of entries, October 23, 2006. A post entry penalty of \$5 per class or \$10 per division will apply without exception. Horses and/or riders who go in a class without entering will be charged a penalty of \$10 plus the regular entry fee.
6. **Entry Blank Must Contain the Following:**
- A) Be properly signed, and, in the case of a minor, signed by a parent or legal guardian.
  - B) Be made on an entry blank provided by the show, (or exact duplicate)
  - C) Show the correct mailing address of the owner.
  - D) Be accompanied by payment of required entry and stall fees.
  - E) Include US Equestrian membership numbers and a photocopy of all membership cards, or a non-member fee plus discipline fee for each owner, lessee, agent, trainer or rider.
  - F) Show Amateur certification if entered in Amateur Classes.
  - G) Show US Equestrian recording number if entered in Jumper Classes.
  - H) Please send copies of All US Equestrian Membership and Measurement cards with entries.
7. **Limitations on entries:** Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class. Refused entries will be refunded all entry fees.
8. **Refunds::**
- A) Before the closing of entries, all fees shall be refunded.
  - B) After the closing of entries, prior to arrival on the show grounds, entry fees shall be refunded only upon presentation of a statement signed by a veterinarian, (or medical doctor, in the case of an amateur owner or equitation rider) stating that the horse (rider) is unable to perform in the classes entered. **A \$35 fee will be assessed on all refund requests.**
  - C) Once on grounds All vet outs must be submitted in writing by official show veterinarian to be considered for a refund. **ALL VET OUT REQUEST MUST BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING BEFORE NOVEMBER 12, 2006. NO REFUNDS WILL BE AUTHORIZED AFTER THE HORSE SHOW HAS CONCLUDED.**
  - D) In all divisions that are entered by complete section no refund will be considered when the horse shows in any class of the division.
9. **Returned Checks:** Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense, and will be handled according to the following procedure: **A \$50 Penalty will be assessed for every returned check.** Accounts will be given ten (10) days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent or they will be turned into the US Equestrian for further disciplinary action.
10. **Unpaid Charges:** Any exhibitor leaving the show with unpaid entry fees or stall fees will be billed for these charges, and a \$35 billing fee will be added to the total due.

11. **Prizes and Championships:**

A) **Prize Money:** Prize money checks will be mailed or hand delivered to the owner within 30 days after the show. Social Security number of OWNER is required before any prize money will be paid. All purses and add-backs shall be divided as follows unless otherwise specified. Prize money divided through 6th place except where otherwise noted:

**1st -30% 2nd-24% 3rd-18% 4th-12% 5th-9% 6th-7%**

B) **Add-Backs:** In classes with add back, prize money is computed from the number of horses that actually show. HORSES ENTERED BUT NOT SHOWN WILL FORFEIT THEIR ADD-BACK MONEY TO THE SHOW AS A PENALTY FOR NOT INFORMING MANAGEMENT OF THEIR SCRATCH.

C) **Ribbons:** Ribbons shall be awarded to eighth place in all classes. All class winners will receive a trophy.

D) **Championships and Reserve Champion Awards:** Championship trophies will be awarded in a division, **Except:** Hi-Low Hunters, Schooling Hunters, Schooling Pony, Junior/Amateur Schooling Jumper and Junior/Amateur Training Jumpers. In all Hunter Championships, the titles shall be awarded to the top two of the six horses which have acquired the most points over fences. In addition to these points, only these six horses shall receive full points for ribbons awarded in Under Saddle classes and half points for ribbons won in Model Classes.

Jumper Championships shall be awarded on a point basis 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5.

Hunter Championships shall be awarded on a point basis of 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5.

Ties in US Equestrian Hunter Championships shall be hacked off as specified in USEF Rules.

Ties in all other Hunter championships shall be decided by the flip of a coin.

12. **Order of Go:** There will be a posted order of go for ALL classes in the Main Ring. All entries will be expected to appear promptly in order. Any conflicts with Hunter Annex **MUST** be resolved with the Paddock Master at the main arena. Riders may sign in with Paddock Master at the Hunter Annex, but will be expected to appear promptly.

13. **Management:** The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, their decision is to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibitor of entries, and cancel award prizes without claim for damages, to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors, to change rings or judges, to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule. If there are four or more entries in a "A" rated hunter section, said section will not be cancelled.

14. **Feed/Bedding:** Bedding may be purchased on the grounds at reasonable market prices. Orders must be paid either by cash or check. A signed "open" check may be left at the Horse Show Office for stable accounts. For your convenience bedding may be ordered when making entries. Please indicated number of bags on entry form.

15. The National Western Events Center main arena is 150' x 200', the annex arena is 85' x 185', the schooling arena is 150' x 100'. The footing is a mix of sand and loam.

16. **Courtesy Circle:** Management may at any time decide to limit the Courtesy Circle in any Hunter class. At least one hour notice will be given and the limits of the circle will be posted on the course plan and will be announced.

17. **Dogs:** Due to Liability restrictions **NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.**

18. **Golf Carts:** Golf Carts are not allowed in the barns or on grounds during the Show for Champions.

19. **Combining Sections:** If fewer than five (5) entries are received by the closing date of entries for split sections of hunters or jumper, sections WILL be combined at the discretion of show management.

# US Equestrian Federation Zone 8 Regional Finals

## No Entry Fee

**Eligibility:** Horses and riders must be recorded with USEF prior to the start of the show.

**Winners will receive a Cooler, ribbons through 8th place**

### **ZONE FINALS HUNTER CLASSES:**

Two classes out of each division will be designated as the Zone Finals classes. For all Divisions held on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday will count the Final two jumping classes. Divisions held on Saturday and Sunday (Adult/Amateur, Childrens, Amateur-Owner and Junior Hunter) will count the First two jumping classes. Hunter awards will be presented at party during the course change break on Saturday afternoon. Jumper and Equitation awards will be presented in the ring immediately following the class.

The open numerical scoring system will be used. The scores from the two rounds will be added to determine the winner. In the case of a tie the second score will determine the winner. Ties for other than first place will remain tied.

**HUNTER BREEDING DIVISIONS:** Zone Champion will be determined by total points won in the two divisions offered. In case of a tie, the Main Hunter Judge's decision will prevail.

### **ZONE FINALS EQUITATION CLASSES:**

Class 227 - Combined Junior/Children's. Fences at 3' and 3'6". Please see details on page 21.

Class 228 - Adults. To be held over a course of 8 to 10 fences, 3'0" in height with spreads not to exceed fence height.

### **ZONE FINALS JUMPER CLASSES:**

Class # 198 - Adult Amateur/Childrens Jumper Classic. May be entered for no entry fee for the Zone Finals but will not be eligible for other awards.

Class # 199 - Junior/Amateur-Owner Jumper: Mile High Grand Prix. May be entered for no entry fee for Zone Finals only but will not be eligible for other awards.

**SCHOOLING:**

Schooling is open to all horses as an opportunity to school over the hunter jumps. Schooling will be allowed Monday, November 6th, 2006 from 2:00 P.M. until 6:00 P.M. If time permits, schooling will be allowed in the hunter rings at the beginning and end of each show day at the discretion of management. **7 OF 8 HUNTERS:** Horses will be shown over a course of approximately 8 fences. Rider may elect, after completing the course, to eliminate any one fence in the course. He must inform the judge of his choice **WITHOUT CONSULTING ANY OTHER PERSON.** Judges may, at their discretion, present special awards to those riders who make the best or worst choices.

Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in all sections to two of the top four horses that acquired the most points performing over a regulation course with obstacles at the full height required in the section in which shown. Only these horses receive half points for ribbons won in Model Classes and full points for ribbons won in Under Saddle Classes. ( See Rules XXIV, Chapter11)
